Comments on Goals, Policies & Actions from Town Plan Meeting

Kent Hansen:

- 1) Cultural Resources - I suggest adding a policy specifically continuing to support the Greensboro Free Library - it is the cultural center of Greensboro.
- 2) Economic Development Actions - #2 I'd suggest deleting the words "interest in and" — just going right to feasibility which certainly fits with the vision of a community that makes conserving natural resources a high priority. I would also add the Town Hall and Lakeview Elementary to the list of organizations that could be positively impacted by the rate water system.
- 3) Education Policies #3 - "an affordable cost" seems awfully subjective.... How about - Develop school budgets that focus on the need for a quality educational experience for the town's children.
- 4) Energy Conservation Actions #2 - It seems that this will require a town building permit system with inspection guidelines and inspectors.
- 5) Housing Policies #2 - It again seems that this will require a town building permit system with inspection guidelines and inspectors.
- 7) Natural Resources Action 3c - In my mind this requirement should be included in the exchange of all properties in Greensboro, not just lakefront properties. Such action fits within the Natural Resource Goals and the second vision of the overall Plan.

John Schweitzer: Natural Resources/Land Use/Energy

Mention traditional recreation of hunting and fishing.

Can we do something about use of salt on roads?

Does not see a "negative trend in shore vegetation/aquatic habitat"

Prohibit manure spreading at a setback distance from lake rather than lake road boundary

Should there be a limit to the amount of conserved land in Greensboro?

Allow smaller lot sizes in rural areas as well

Promote energy efficiency in Greensboro buildings, too
